GLAZED PORCELAIN TILES

Glazed Porcelain tiles are very hard wearing and have a water absorption less than 0.1 percent which makes them very easy to maintain. These tiles generally do not stain so sealing is not a requirement.

GROUT SMEAR REMOVAL

After the tiles have been grouted there will be a grout smear on the surface of the tiles to remove, the following steps should be followed.

1. Wait 3-5 days for the grout to cure, and then scrub the floor with a nylon scouring pad and **Spirit Phosphoric Acid Cleaner** at a dilution on 8 parts water to 1 part acid.
2. Remove all the acid solution from the floor and rinse thoroughly with **Spirit Neutral Cleaner**.

MAINTENANCE

These tiles have a semi glazed surface which means if not maintained they will acquire a build up of soils. Commercial sites may need maintenance on a more regular basis.

1. For general maintenance of the floor use **Spirit Neutral Cleaner**.
2. For heavy built up areas use **Spirit H.D.C.** and scrub with a nylon scouring pad.
3. For Stubborn scuff marks use **Spirit Porcelain Crème Cleaner**.
4. If used in a commercial bathroom the follow marks should be treated with the correct cleaning products:
 - Urine – **Spirit Bright As**
 - Paint – **Spirit Safe Stripper**
 - Oil – **Spirit H.D.C.**
 - Soap scum – **Spirit H.D.C.** or **Spirit Porcelain Crème Cleaner**
 - Rust – **Spirit Phosphoric Acid Cleaner**
 - Nail Polish – Acetone (available from a hardware store)
5. For general maintenance of the floor use **Spirit Neutral Cleaner**.
6. For heavy built up areas use **Spirit H.D.C.** and scrub with a nylon scouring pad
7. For spot cleaning of stubborn marks use **Spirit Porcelain Crème Cleaner**.
