

PORCELAIN & CERAMIC TILE MAINTENANCE GUIDE

MAINTENANCE

The floor should be cleaned regularly with **Spirit Neutral Cleaner**. If the method of cleaning is mopping, it is very important that the mop water should be changed every 10-20 square metres to prevent the dirt being spread across the entire floor.

A wet and dry vacuum is the ideal way to remove the dirty water.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u> - Spills should be cleaned up as soon as possible to reduce the risk of staining to your tile or the grout joints.

- 1. For general maintenance of the floor, use Spirit Neutral Cleaner.
- 2. For heavy build-up of grease and grime, or long term wear, use Spirit H.D.C.

The following marks should be treated with the correct cleaning products...

- Tyre marks/scuff marks Spirit Porcelain Crème
- Marker pens/crayon Spirit Porcelain Crème
- Pencil marks Spirit Porcelain Crème
- Wax Spirit Porcelain Crème
- Soap scum Spirit Porcelain Crème

- Waterbased paint Spirit H.D.C.
- Tea & coffee Spirit H.D.C.
- Wine & Beer Spirit H.D.C.
- Cooking oil Spirit H.D.C.
- Grease and grime Spirit H.D.C.
- Mould, mildew & algae Spirit Bright As
- Bird droppings & leaf marks Spirit Bright As
- Grout haze/cement residue Spirit Phosphoric Acid Cleaner or Spirit Safe Acid
- Rust marks Spirit Phosphoric Acid Cleaner
- Efflorescence Spirit Efflorescence Off or Spirit Safe Acid.
- *For the best results...Spirit recommends to rinse with **Spirit Neutral Cleaner** (a pH neutral detergent) after cleaning with any of our other heavier duty cleaners listed above. A dilution rate of at least 20 parts water to 1 part **Spirit Neutral Cleaner** is required.
